Coffee, tea, and water will be provided but BYOB for other beverages. All participants will receive a compilation of all recipes for dishes presented at the tasting, and they will have the opportunity to join in some of the dances.



## Guidelines

- Pre-registration is required
  - registration fee (cash or check) must accompany the registration form
  - make checks payable to Lake / Sumter AAUW
  - members can register at the February General Meeting or by ground mail
  - registration deadline is March 19, 2019, but sooner is better
- > Every AAUW member must bring a dish representing a diverse culture or cuisine
  - the dish must be specified on the registration form
  - the dish can be an appetizer, main dish, side dish, or dessert
  - each dish should serve 12 16 people (although they will be sampled in small portions)
  - each dish should be accompanied by serving utensils
  - one dish will cover the registration of a member and one other person (spouse/partner/guest)
  - for additional guests, there should be one dish for every two people
  - if the dish requires portioning before the event, pre-slice in sample-sized portions
- > The person who prepared the dish must submit an electronic copy of the recipe
  - each recipe must include the name of the dish, where the cook got it from (e.g., greatgrandmother, the internet, etc.) and its heritage/country or culture of origin
  - deadline for submitting recipes is March 19, 2019
